



AUTOMATIC POWER-OFF TIMER

WHAT IS IT?

- All current Acura models include a feature called the automatic power-off timer, which is designed to switch the vehicle from ACCESSORY mode to OFF after 30 to 60 minutes of use

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- With the transmission in PARK on CVT and automatic-transmission models, the timer starts when the ENGINE START/STOP button is pushed once to engage ACCESSORY mode
- The audio system and other accessories can then be used
- If the vehicle remains in ACCESSORY mode from 30 to 60 minutes, the system will automatically switch the power to OFF
- When manual-transmission models are in ACCESSORY mode, the steering wheel does not lock. You cannot lock or unlock doors with the remote transmitter or the keyless access system. Press the ENGINE START/STOP button twice to switch the mode to VEHICLE OFF (LOCK)

WHY IS IT INCLUDED?

- To help prevent the vehicle's battery from being drained

NOTE THAT:

- To fully recharge the battery after the timer has switched off the power, start the engine and drive the vehicle several miles
- Never leave children, pets or people needing assistance unattended in the vehicle
